12th Annual Diwali Workshop

Radhatri Nethralaya conducted its twelfth annual Diwali workshop on first aid following cracker injuries to the eyes on 24/10/2024 at its premises. 80 school students and teachers from several city schools attended and benefited from the hands on workshop under the aegis of Rotary club of Chennai Towers. The workshop was conducted by Dr. Vasumathy Vedantham, medical director, Radhatri Nethralaya.

The students enacted out several scenarios of cracker injuries under her expert guidance. Dr. Vasumathy Vedantham said blindness due to cracker injuries are on the rise with sparklers causing the most damage. Simple first aid measures if done promptly would go a long way in reducing needless blindness, she added. All the participating students received certificates of participation and first aid kits from the hands of the chief guests Rajasthan Ratna Shri Subash Chand Ranka. Dr. Praveen Krishna, Medical Director Radhatri Nethralaya, Rotarian Shalin Shah, President RC Chennai towers and Rtn Krishnachander were present.

About 50,000 pamphlets with detailed information on first aid measures were distributed to the school students to take back to their schools. The students were encouraged to partake the knowledge gained in the workshop by conducting plays and workshops in their schools involving their fellow students. Dr.Praveen Krishna & Dr.Vasumathy Vedantham, Medical directors Radhatri Nethralaya and Shri Subash Chand Ranka oversee the students practising the first aid measures.

The 12th Annual Project RADAR (Radhatri Nethralaya Diabetic Retinopathy Project in Association with Rotary) which is a month long Free Diabetic Retinopathy screening for the public was launched at Radhatri Nethralaya on the occasion of World Diabetes day.

It was inaugurated by Prof Dr. Mani, Dean Omandurar Medical college and Rtn KV Sundaram, CEO Universal FABCO under the aegis of Rotary club of Chennai Towers.

The dignitaries released pamphlets to promote awareness on Diabetic Retinopathy to be distributed amongst the public and gave away certificates to 30 medical students and school students who were present certifying them as "Yuva Nethra Jyotis" : Youth Vision Ambassadors who would promote awareness about diabetic retinopathy in the community. Demonstration of how vision could be impaired in diabetic retinopathy by means of customised glasses and use of a novel artificial intelligence (AI) based retinal camera to detect diabetic retinopathy in less than a minute was done. This camera would be employed for detection of diabetic retinopathy in public places, parks, urban slums etc over the next one month.





The AI based camera donated by Kotak Life was used in the camps.
